Grants

We received a grant for \$74,460 to offer students fresh fruit and vegetables during the school day at Freedom Elementary School, Cesar Chavez Middle School and New School High School. This money also helped to provide nutrition education for students, harvest of the month, equipment needed to prepare and store fresh fruits and vegetables and farmers markets at the some of the school sites.

We also received a grant for next school year worth \$132,620.00 to purchase new equipment for some of our kitchens.
