SCHOOL PLANS / SITE COUNCILS

Mandated Action

The Governing Board encourages district employees, students, parents/guardians and other members of the school community to develop school plans based on the school's needs assessment and designed with specific instructional strategies to meet the specific educational needs identified in the basic skills assessment completed at individual school sites. In addition, such plans will address the District's educational goals. The Board may approve or disapprove school plans as necessary in order to fulfill the district's mission and accomplish the Board's adopted goals.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that schools provide for participation in state-funded school-based programs by establishing and maintaining a school site council as required by law. Site councils shall annually receive training in their responsibilities for the guidance of the site program. They shall be apprised of the District's educational goals, the level of student achievement, and proposed instructional strategies to address the educational needs of their students.
