Draw a food web. Label the consumers, producers, decomposers and primary energy source.

Make a visual to illustrate a natural disaster. It could be a model, poster or diorama. Be prepared to share this with the class. (tsunami, earthquake, volcano, mudslide)

Write a short fiction story about what would happen to the Earth if the sun disappeared forever.

Write a short news report on an actual natural disaster that occurred around the world.

Make a game that uses magnets. Be creative.

Create a picture dictionary of renewable and non renewable resources. Be sure to include sun, wind, water, coal, natural gas, oil, and nuclear energy.

Cut out or draw pictures that represent solid, liquid or gas. Paste them on a piece of paper labelled solid, liquid, gas. Each category must have at least 5 pictures.

Create a food chain using pictures from a magazine or the newspaper. It must include a carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.

Using the world map, label the location of five natural disasters. Include the dates. You can find your information in a book or on the Internet.
