Mike is a former Aptos High School Language Arts teacher and was currently working as the Assistant Principal responsible for Guidance and Master Scheduling. He will continue with these duties as well as expand his role as Acting Principal. The Board also approved Barbara Lawrence-Emanuel as full time Assistant Principal till June 30<sup>th</sup>. Barbara was a fifty percent time Academic Learning Center (ALC) Principal at Aptos High School. Her ALC duties will be incorporated into her Assistant Principal duties. Christine Amato Quinn, Assistant Superintendent of the North Zone, will continue to provide leadership to the site. Specifically, Christine will attend the site council, PTA and faculty meetings. Christine will be leading the charge for completing facilities at Aptos High School with the monies from the passage of measure J.
