For families that do not qualify for free or reduced transportation, they will be able to purchase their passes at these same locations. The application and sales schedule is as follows:

August 11<sup>th</sup> through the 15<sup>th</sup>:

- Aptos Jr. High School: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM in the multipurpose room
- E.A. Hall Middle School: 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM in the multipurpose room
- Pajaro Middle School: 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM in the multipurpose Room

August 18<sup>th</sup> through the 22<sup>nd</sup>:

- Aptos High School: 4:00 PM -7:00 PM in the Quad
- Rolling Hills Middle School: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM in the Community Learning Center
- Watsonville High School: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM in the cafeteria.

In addition, bus passes will be available to purchase throughout the year at the Pajaro Valley Unified School District Office in the Construction Department, 294 Green Valley Road, Watsonville.

When purchasing the passes, the district will accept cash, checks, or credit cards (Visa/Master Card).
