

5 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT Medi-Cal Expansion for Undocumented Young Adults

Medi-Cal has expanded to include undocumented young adults up to the age of 26!



- 1 Beginning January 1, 2020, all low-income young adults, ages 19 through 25, can enroll in Medi-Cal. Your immigration status does not matter!
- 2 You can enroll in emergency Medi-Cal NOW and automatically receive full-scope coverage when the program starts in January. You can get more information and confidential help applying at a clinic or with a community organization. To find a clinic, go to: <http://localclinic.net>
- 3 If you already have “emergency” Medi-Cal, you will be automatically enrolled in full scope services on January 1, 2020. Make sure you keep your Medi-Cal information up to date.
- 4 Full-scope Medi-Cal means you can access health services for FREE or at low cost, including preventive services – like annual check-ups, dental care, and medication.
- 5 This Medi-Cal eligibility for young adults under age 26 does not count as a “public charge.” If you have questions about your immigration status and accessing healthcare, please contact an immigration advocate.
